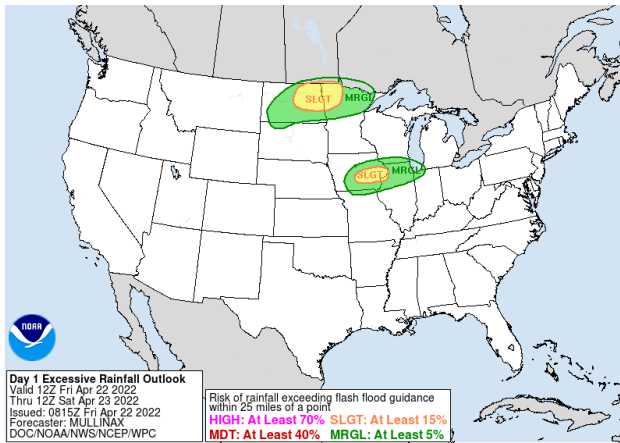

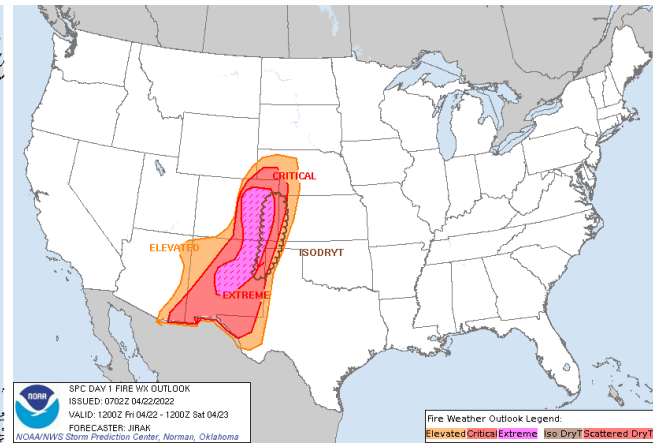
Today's Severe Weather Outlook



Today's Excessive Rainfall Outlook

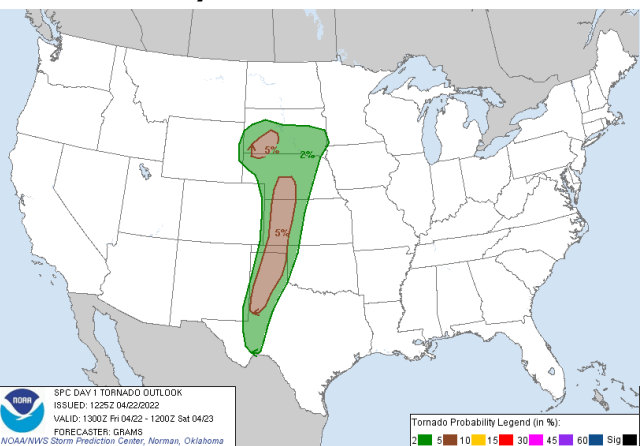

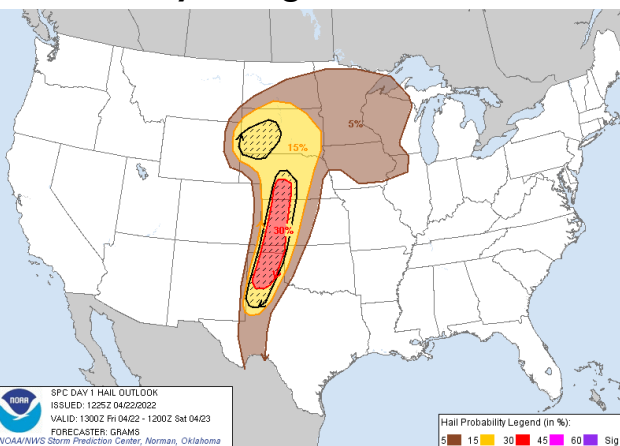

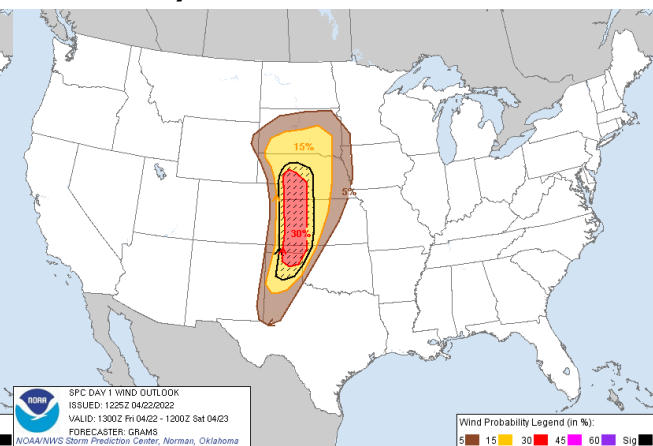

Plains, Palmer Divide, Front Range Foothills & South Park 8 am to 9 pm Today

- Dry, Warm & Very Windy Conditions
- Wind gusts from 60 to 70 mph
- Avoid activities that cause open flames or sparks
- Be Prepared to take action to Protect yourself & your family
- If you smell smoke or see fire, move in a direction opposite the fire immediately

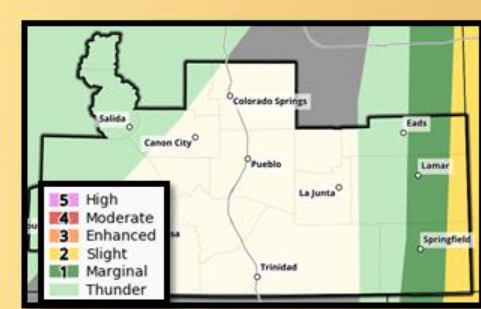

Potential Impacts

- Slick and snow packed roads, especially passes
- Poor visibility due to of blowing snow



Event/Timing

Red Flag Warning
9 AM – 9 PM Fri

Potential Impacts

- Volatile Conditions for fire spread
- AVOID fire starts!



Event/Timing

High Wind Warning
9 AM – Midnight

Potential Impacts

- Southwest winds gusting up to 70 mph
- Dangerous cross winds
- Blowing dust



Event/Timing

Severe Thunderstorms
Late afternoon & evening

Potential Impacts

- Hail up to 2.5 inches
- Gusts over 60 mph
- Isolated tornado possible near KS border

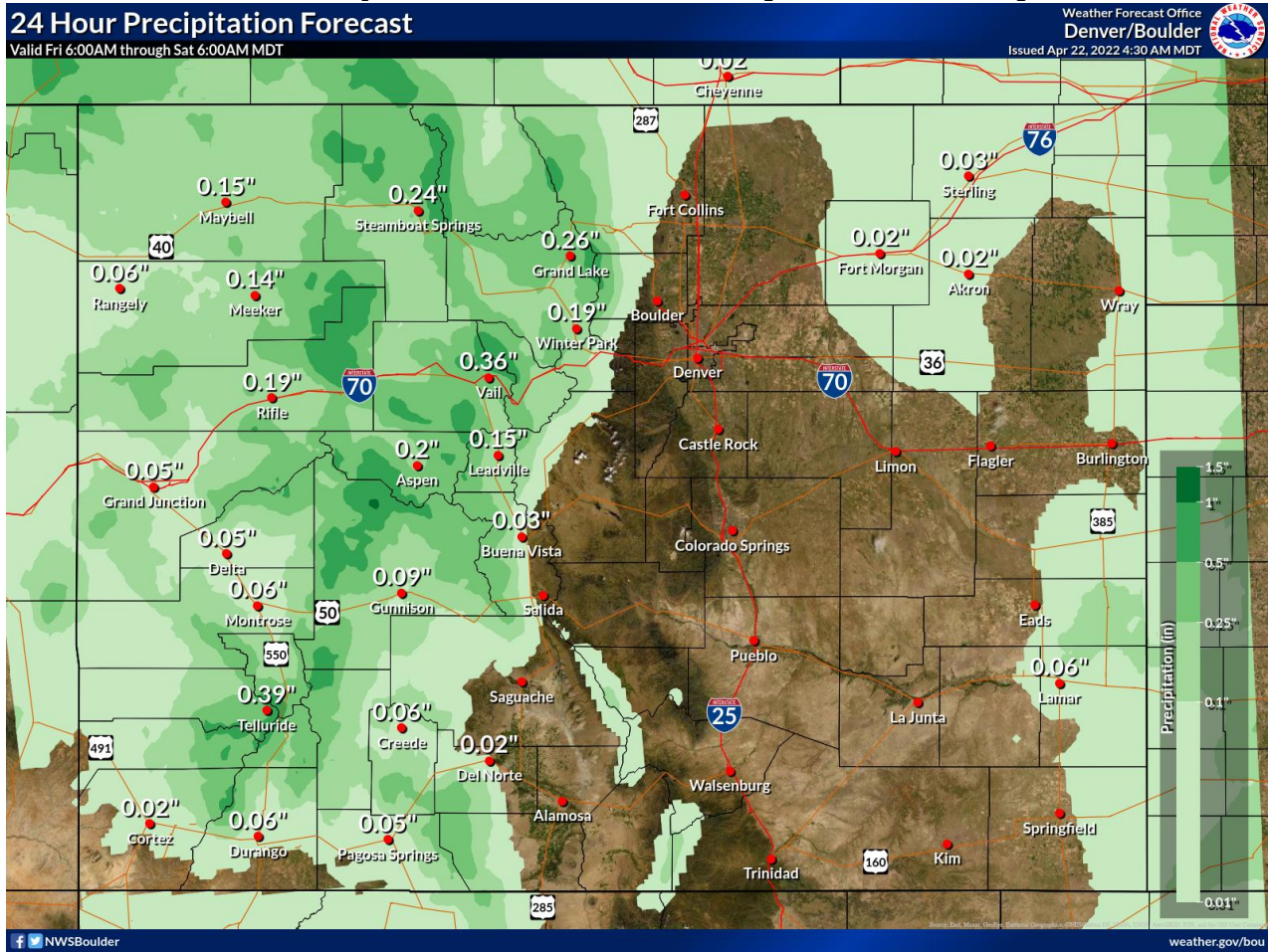

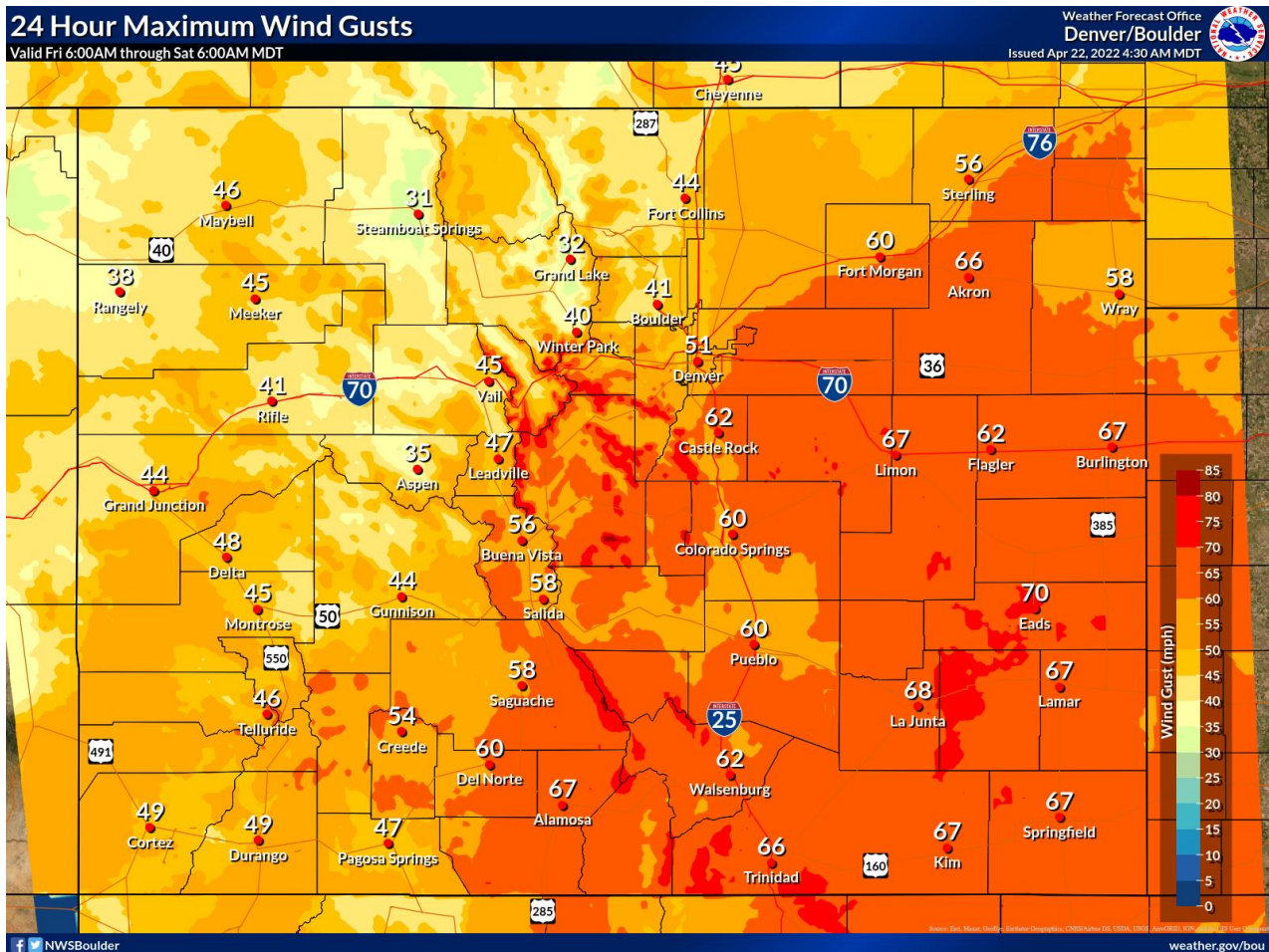

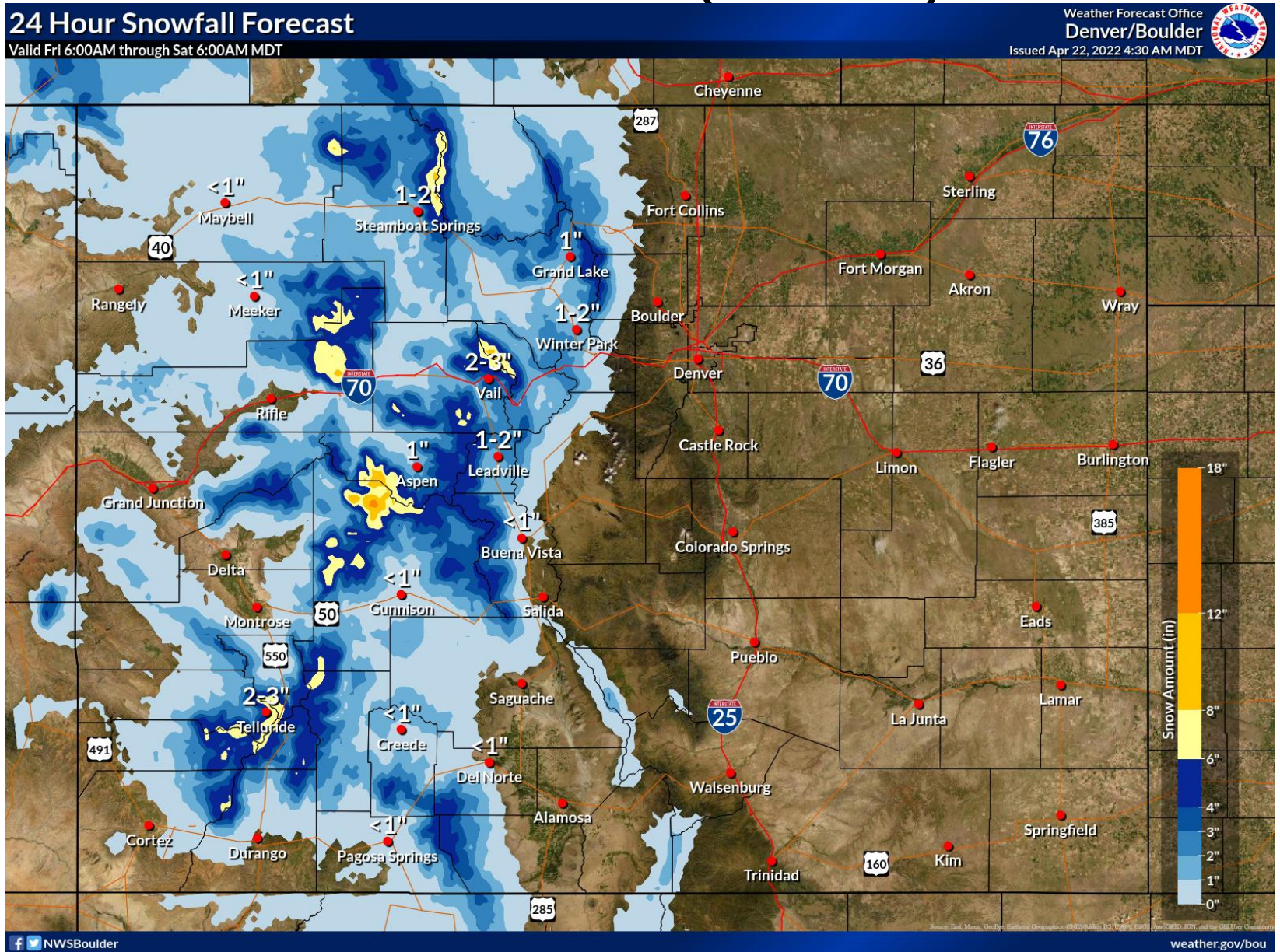
