{Take check-ins.

Conventional check-in procedure is for the check-in station to send just the 1st letter of his callsign suffix, then listen (doubling avoidance) for NCS to echo that letter back. This is the cue for the check-in to go ahead with his/her full call, name, district and either QRU or QTC. Several check-ins may be taken consecutively in this manner before NCS acknowledges.

When the pace slows, ack the group heard:}

DE < ur call > R <call1> <call2> <call3> ... QNI DE < ur call > K

{Repeat until all check-ins are logged and acked, then continue:}

DE < ur call > GM ALL ES TNX BT QNS < list callsigns in order of expected responses > BT QNC THE ? FER 2DAY IS < your invented question for this net > ? BT QNA DE < ur call > K

{In QNS order, each net station will ID and respond to the question and finish with an ID K. This prompts the next station to take his turn. Some new ops may not get the QNA gig - if so then NCS may rattle the cage:}

< next QNA call > DE < ur call > GA K

{After all stations have responded, and time permitting, NCS may send own response and/or ask for comments.}

{Be sure to close the net in time to let folks QSY to 3810 and tune up before 0800.}
